## **FAMILY/SCHOOL AGREEMENT**

*Signature by a parent is required on the Student Registration Form agreeing to abide by the items listed in this Family/School Agreement. Signatures by Junior High and/or Senior High School students are required on the Student Registration Form agreeing to the Student Pledge and to abide by the school rules and regulations found in the CCS Parent-Student Handbook.*

### **1. STUDENT PLEDGE:**

- Coastal Christian School is dedicated to bringing glory to God. Therefore, I pledge to live to the best of my abilities in accordance with what Coastal Christian School represents and believes and to behave as a good example of the type of behavior expected from students of a Christian school that desires to bring glory to God.
- Coastal Christian School is committed to the truth of the Bible and what it teaches about moral and ethical conduct. Therefore, I pledge to abstain, both on and off campus, from the use of tobacco, alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, profane language, and other immoral or unethical behavior.
- Coastal Christian School is dedicated to excellence in all aspect of human endeavor by helping students grow spiritually, emotionally, physically, and academically. Therefore, I pledge to work hard to master the curriculum, participate in school activities, and mature in my Christian walk.
- I have received, read, and will support the Coastal Christian School Statement of Faith.

### **2. PARENTS' PLEDGE:**

- We understand that Coastal Christian School is an institution of learning with the objective of total education centered on Jesus Christ. Its goal is to promote obedience to Christ in the spiritual, intellectual, physical, and social development of each child so that, "... in all things He might have preeminence." Col. 1:18
- We understand that the school aims to support the home by producing students who are dedicated to God and prepared to be used by Him in any area of life the individual shall enter. In this philosophy, we understand the school will expect its families to attend and support a local church and to set an example of faith and obedience to God in all of its endeavors.
- We understand that our child may be required to participate in the saluting of the American flag, the Christian flag, and the Bible. We also understand our child may be required to participate in scripture memory work, chapel services, and in prayer.
- We understand the standards of CCS do not tolerate profanity, obscenity in word or action, dishonor to God or the Word of God, or disrespect to the personnel of the school. We recognize that the school may have standards, which go beyond some of our personal attitudes and opinions as individuals, but we willingly accept the responsibility to uphold school standards, rules, and regulations.
- We pledge that our child's standard of dress will be in good taste and consistent with the student dress code of CCS. We understand our child must abide by the rules of the school dealing with the dress code and the responsibilities the student must up hold in and out of the classroom.
- We hereby invest authority in the school to discipline our child according to Christian principles and as outlined in the Parent-Student Handbook. We agree that, if our child should become involved in any trouble with other students, teachers, or administrators, we shall cooperate in every way, through prayer and appropriate actions to solve such trouble. If, after reasonable effort has been made to remediate our child's behavior, and/or to assist his or her academic adjustment, and the student does not comply with the standards of the school, we understand the student may be removed from the school.

- We agree to notify the school of any change of address, telephone numbers, or employment no later than 5 days of the change.
- We agree to pay all tuition and fees promptly. We understand that assessments can be made to cover loss or damage to school property caused by our child. Possible assessments include but are not limited to the following:
  - A list of current school tuition and fees is in the Parent-Student Handbook and on the school website.
  - To cover damage or loss of property caused by our child(ren).
  - School records may be withheld until assessments and unpaid (non-tuition) fees are paid.
  - Unpaid assessments or tuition will impact registration status on the following year's enrollment.
- We give our consent and submission to all governing policies of the school. It is understood that the services of the school are engaged by mutual consent, and that either the school or we reserve the right to terminate any or all services at any time. Admission to Coastal Christian School is a privilege. We understand that not complying with the standards of CCS, as set forth above, may be justification for the removal of our child from the school.

### **3. Statement of Faith:**

CCS Believes:

- The Bible to be the inspired, the only infallible authoritative Word of God.
- There is one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
- In the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, in His miracles, in His vicarious and atoning death through His shed blood, in His bodily resurrection, in His ascension to the right hand of the Father, and in His personal return in power and glory.
- In the resurrection of both the saved and the lost, they that are saved unto the resurrection of life, and they that are lost unto the resurrection of damnation.
- In the spiritual unity of believers of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- In the present ministry of the Holy Spirit by indwelling the Christian enabling him to live a godly life.
